Pursuant to Section **5.1.10.23 NMAC**, Before implementing any changes to a surveillance system plan, the licensee shall submit the proposed changes to the board for approval. If, after reviewing the gaming operator licensee's proposed changes, the board determines that the proposed plan is not adequate, the board shall notify the gaming operator licensee in writing. The gaming operator licensee shall revise the proposed plan and submit it to the board for approval or request a hearing within 30 days after receipt of the board's written notice. Failure to submit a revised plan for board approval constitutes an unsuitable method of operation, unless a hearing has been requested in accordance with this subsection.
