Shipment Instructions for Gaming Devices and Media

Prior to shipment of any Gaming Machine into the New Mexico non-Tribal jurisdiction, the following procedures shall be followed. Please reference Board Rule, 15.1.16 NMAC for licensee specific requirements.

1. The New Mexico Gaming Control Board (NMGCB) shall be notified prior to any shipment using the following form.
 - Application to Transport Gaming Device or Gaming Media
 - a. The same form shall be used for the notification of transport for Gaming Devices and/or Gaming Media into, out of, or within the State of NM.
 - b. The Application is used to supply the particular information for who is initiating the shipment, method of shipment, destination and dates.
 - c. The shipper shall attach to the application, documentation that at a minimum includes the following information: Manufacturer, Description, S/N (if applicable), P/N of each item that is to be included (NO UPPER LEVEL P/N's)
 - d. Please note, Gaming Media shall ship separately from the Gaming Device.
 - e. All Gaming Media shall be shipped directly to the destination and shall include in the address block: ATTN: NMGCB Enforcement.
2. Once the form has been completed by the originator, the form will be emailed to GCB-Transport@state.nm.us. Once received, the form will be assigned a transport control number(s) and the originator will be notified by email. Please note, NMGCB reserves a minimum of three (3) business days to respond to the originator.
3. The originator shall enter the NMGCB assigned control number on the original notarized form and mail the original forms to:

4. **A copy of the completed forms shall accompany the shipment.**
5. **Jurisdictional wait.** There is **no** wait requirement for the New Mexico Jurisdiction. Upon notification of the control number(s) the shipment may occur. If there is a change in shipping dates the NMGCB must be notified and may require an amended form to be submitted.
